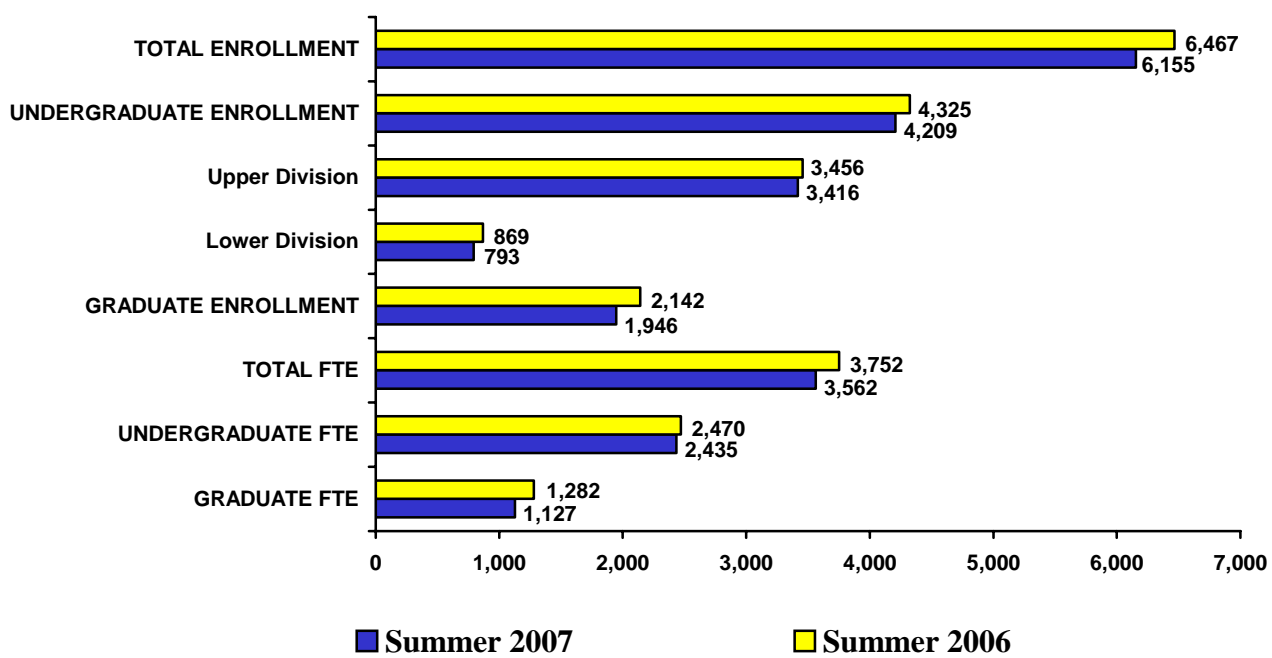


# Enrollment Fact Sheet Summer, 2007

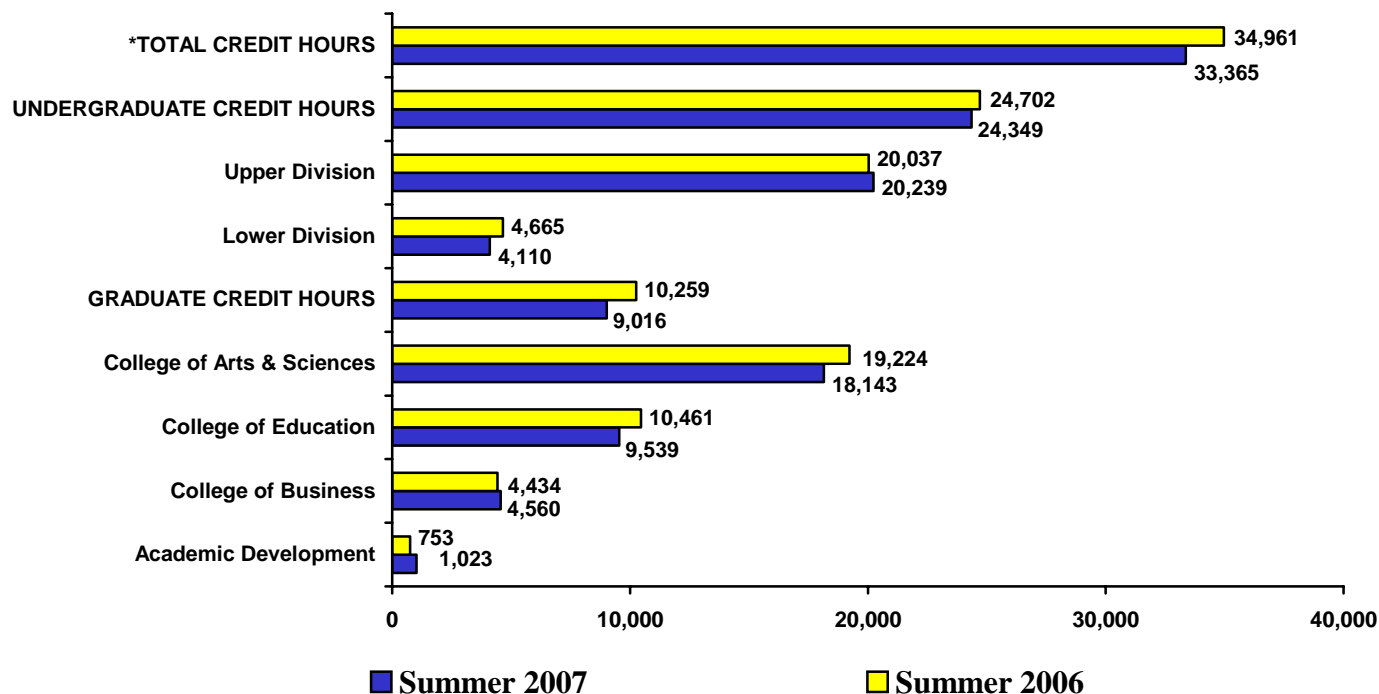

## Comparison of Student Enrollment and FTE



- A total of 6,155 students enrolled in the 2007 Summer session. This represents a 4.8% decrease from Summer 2006 enrollments; total student FTE also declined 5.1%.
- While a decline in enrollment was seen at all levels, the most notable decreases were found at the lower division and graduate level, 8.7% and 9.2%, respectively. At the graduate level, there was a 6.6% decrease in the enrollment of classified graduate students, as well as a 16.2% decrease for unclassified graduate students.

## Comparison of Student Credit Hours by Level and by College



\*Total Credit Hours includes Honors, NSEP, and non-traditional credit hours.

- Student Credit Hours generated during the Summer 2007 sessions decreased 4.6% over the previous summer; undergraduate student credit hours fell 1.4%, while graduate credit hours declined 12.1%.
- As with the Spring 2007 semester, the large increase in student credit hours generated by Academic Development (35.9%) is due to the recent creation of a new math course in that area.
