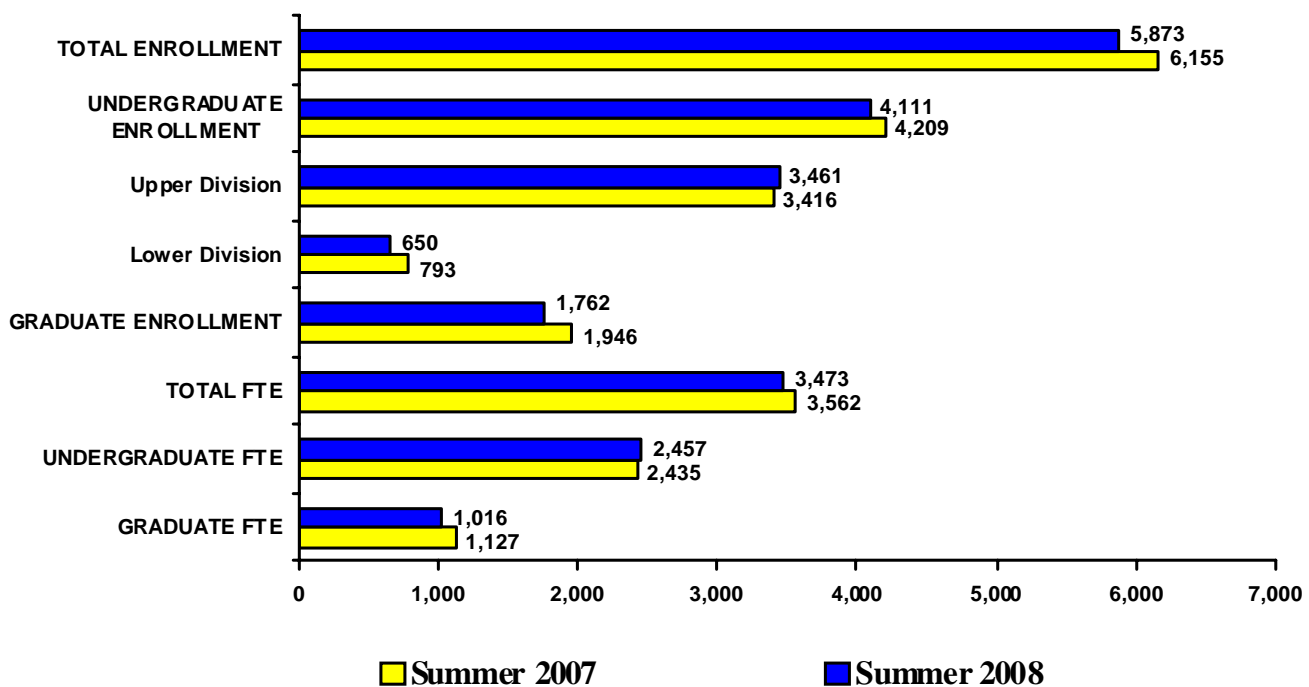


# Enrollment Fact Sheet Summer, 2008

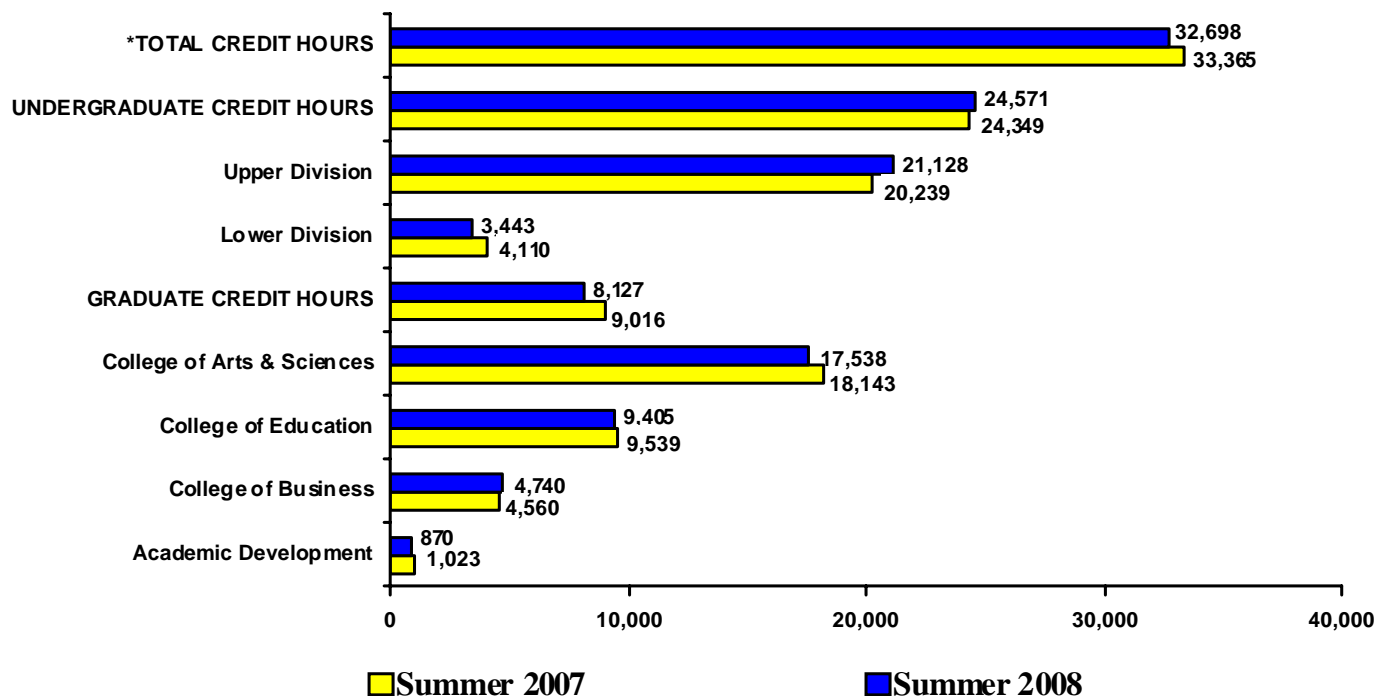

## Comparison of Student Enrollment and FTE



- A total of 5,873 students enrolled in the 2008 Summer session. This represents a 4.6% decrease from Summer 2007 enrollments; total student FTE also declined by 2.5%.
- While a decline in enrollment was seen at almost all levels, the most notable decreases were found at the lower division and graduate level, 18.0% and 9.5%, respectively.

## Comparison of Student Credit Hours by Level and by College



\*Total Credit Hours includes Honors, NSEP, and non-traditional credit hours.

- Student Credit Hours generated during the Summer 2008 sessions decreased by 2.0% over the previous summer; undergraduate student credit hours increased by 0.9%, while Academic Development and graduate credit hours declined by 15.0% and 9.9%, respectively.
