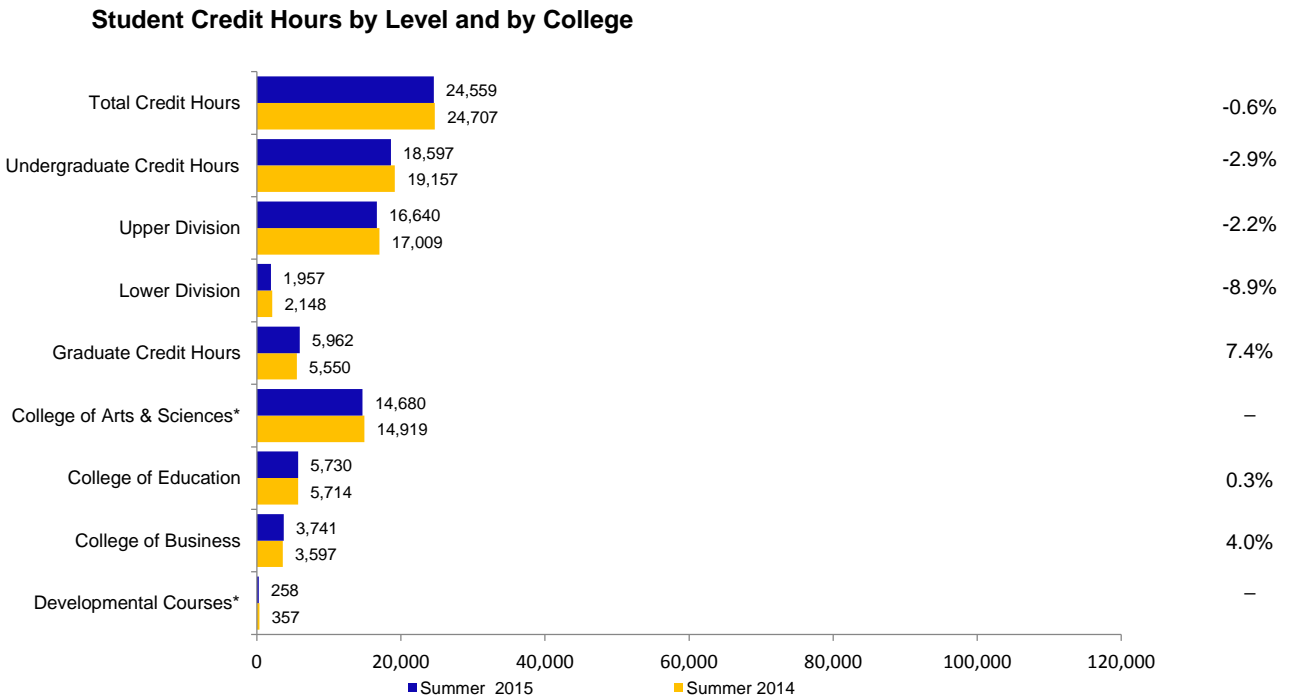
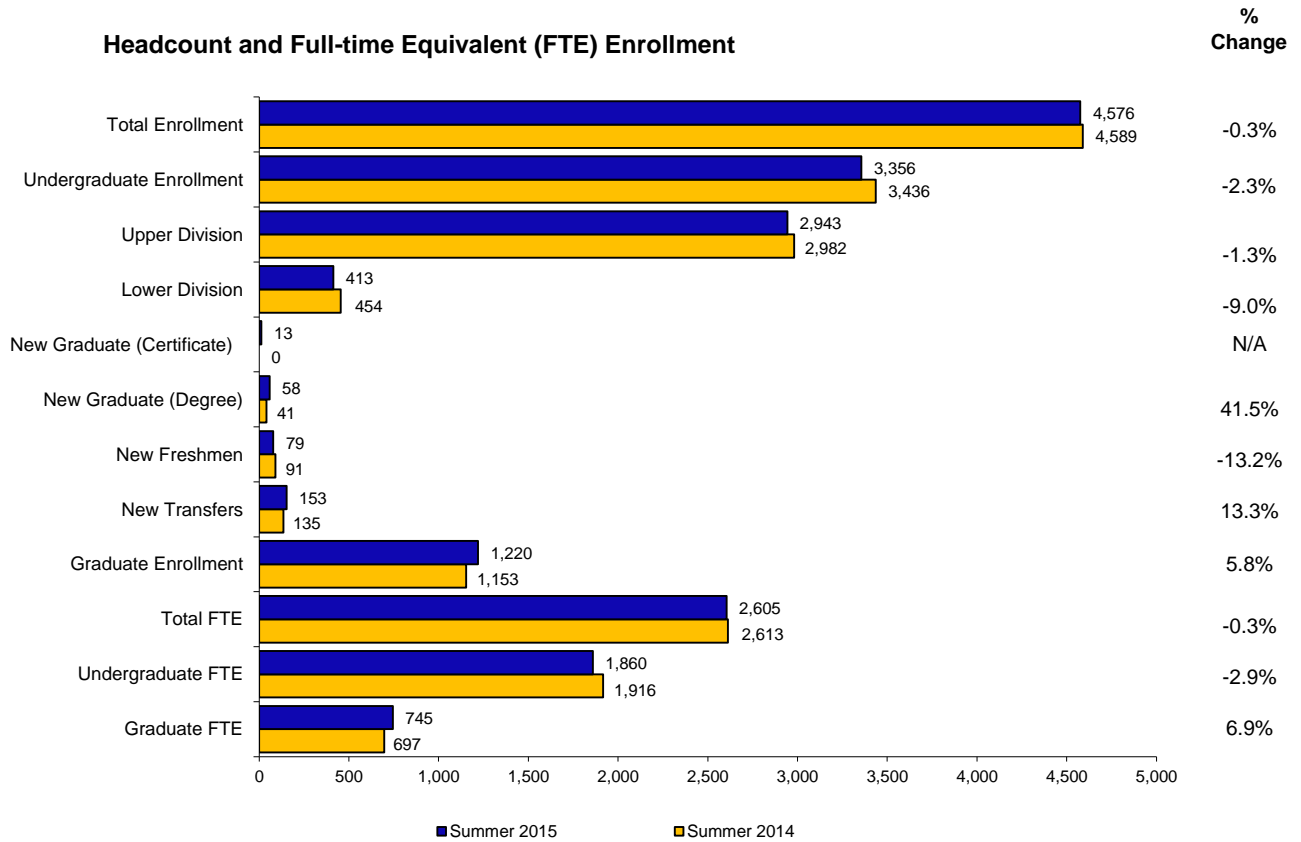


Enrollment Fact Sheet Summer 2015
