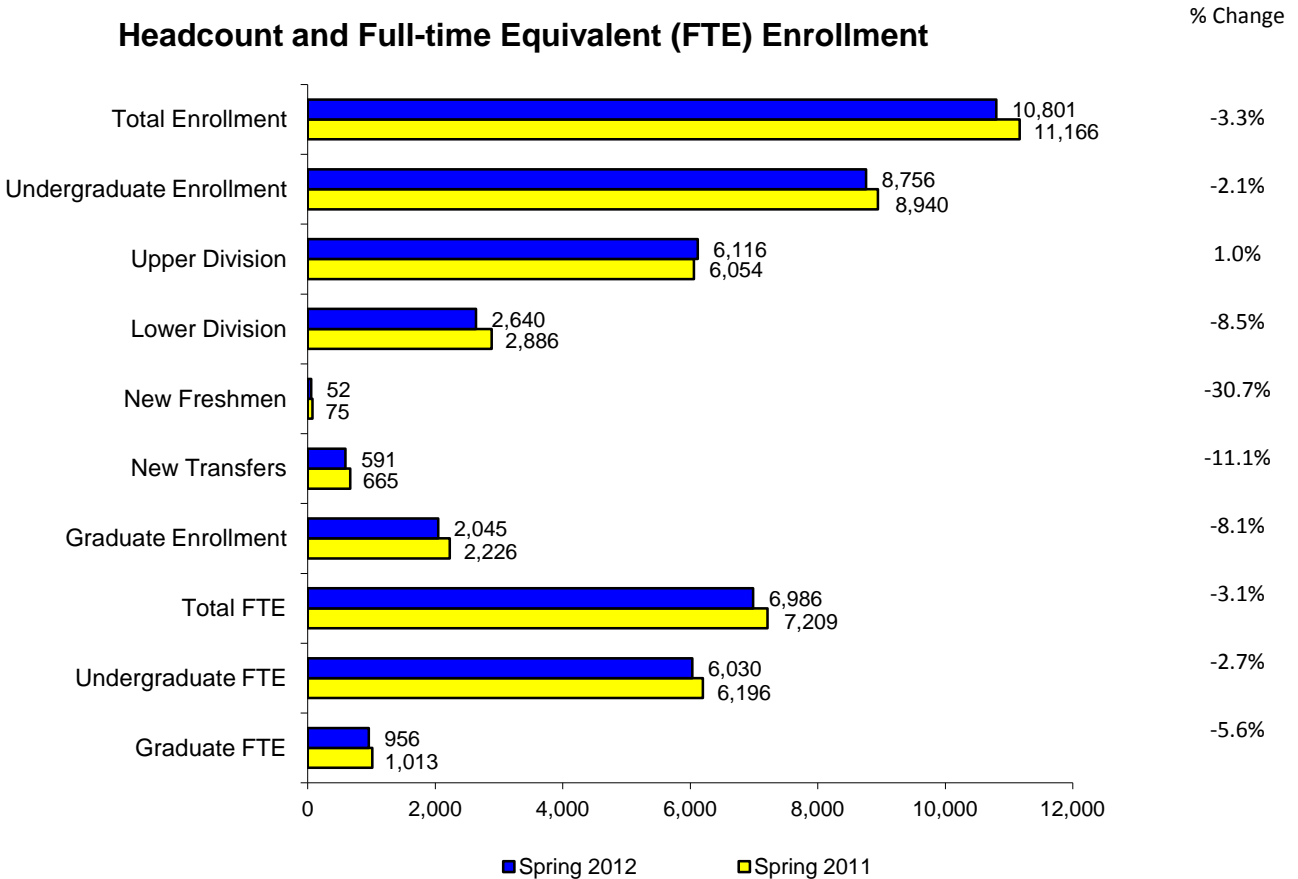


Enrollment Fact Sheet

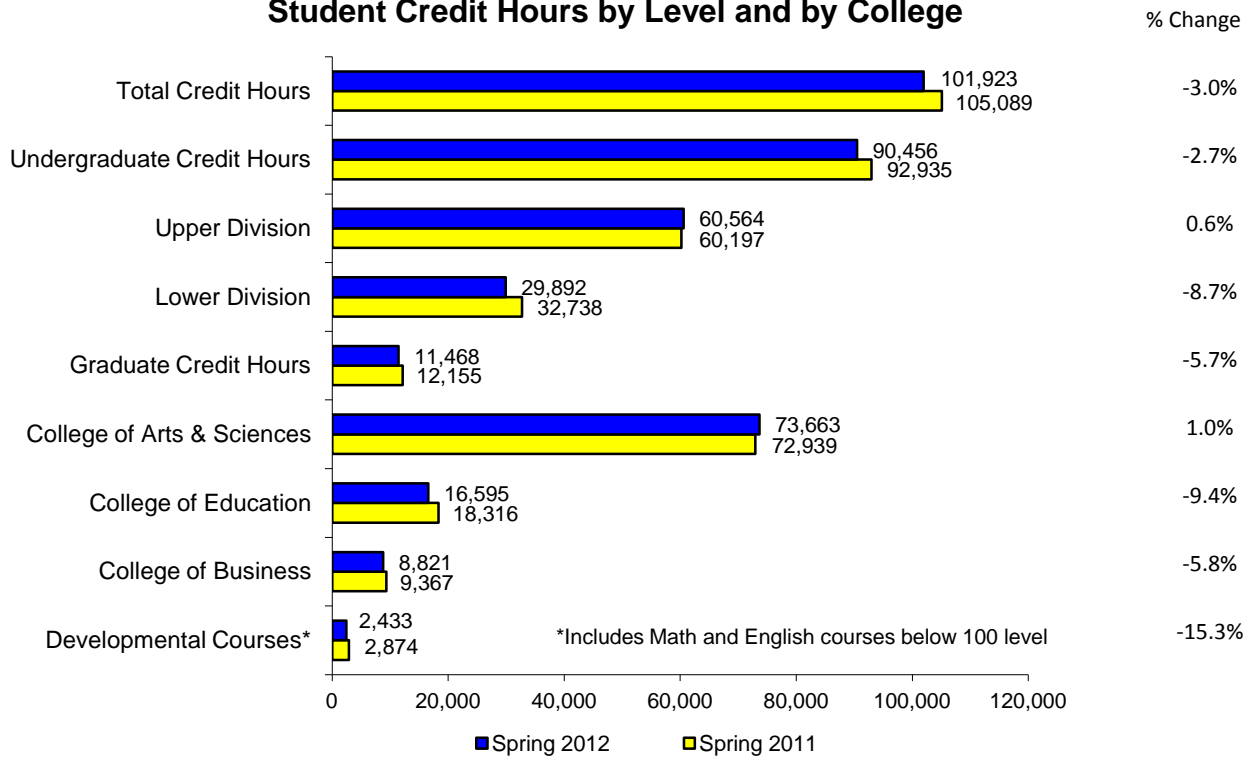

- Total headcount enrollment in Spring 2012 is 10,801 students, representing over 3 percent decrease from the previous spring term. Total FTE enrollment decreased by a similar amount.
- Undergraduate enrollment totals 8,756 students, down 2.1 percent; undergraduate FTE enrollment also decreased at 2.7 percent from the previous spring term. Enrollment in the upper division was the only area that showed increase. New freshmen enrollment decreased from 75 to 52 students (30.7 percent), and new transfer enrollment fell from 665 to 591 students (11.1 percent).
- Graduate enrollment totals 2,045 students, down 8.1 percent from the previous spring. Graduate FTE enrollment shows a decrease of 5.6 percent.

Student Credit Hours by Level and by College



- The total number of student credit hours generated in Spring 2012 is 101,923, decreased by 3 percent from the previous spring term. Nearly the entire decrease came in lower division undergraduate (down 8.7 percent) and graduate-level (down 5.7 percent) credit hours, while the number of upper division credit hours held steady (0.6 percent increase)
- College of Arts and Sciences generated 73,663 student credit hours, accounting for 72.3 percent of the university total. Student credit hours in the Education and Business disciplines declined 9.4 and 5.8 percent respectively. Developmental courses decreased by over 15 percent. Arts and Science showed the only increase at 724 student credit hours or 1 percent.
