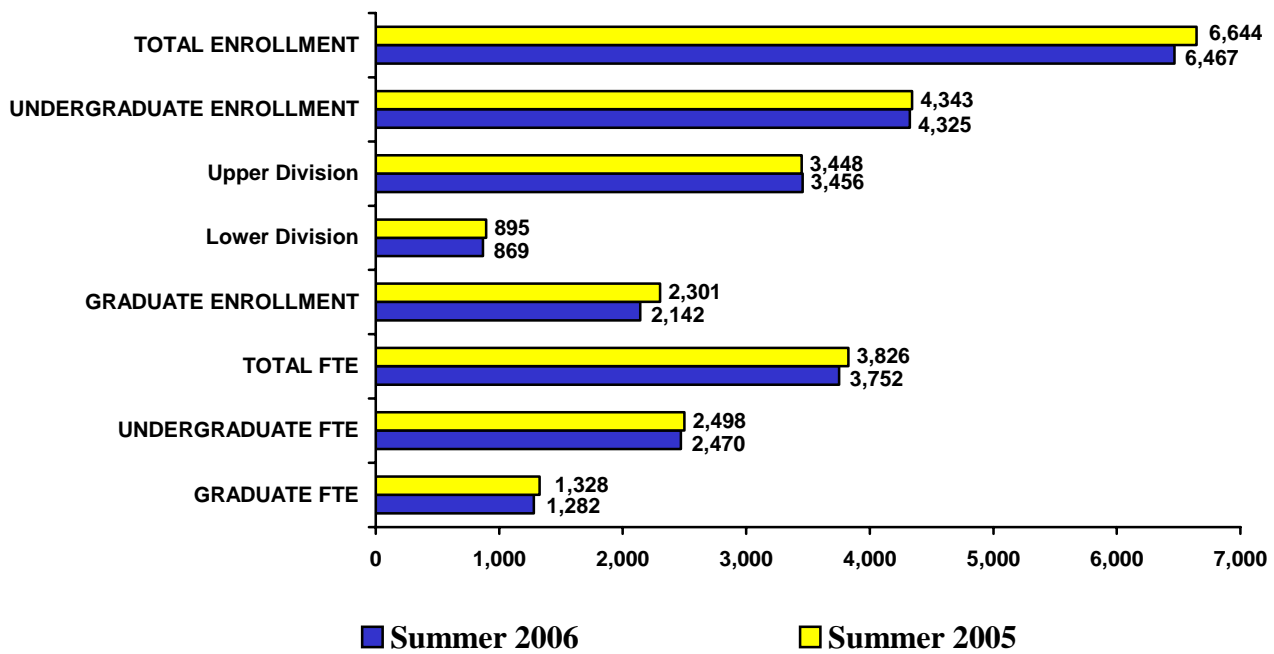


# Enrollment Fact Sheet Summer, 2006

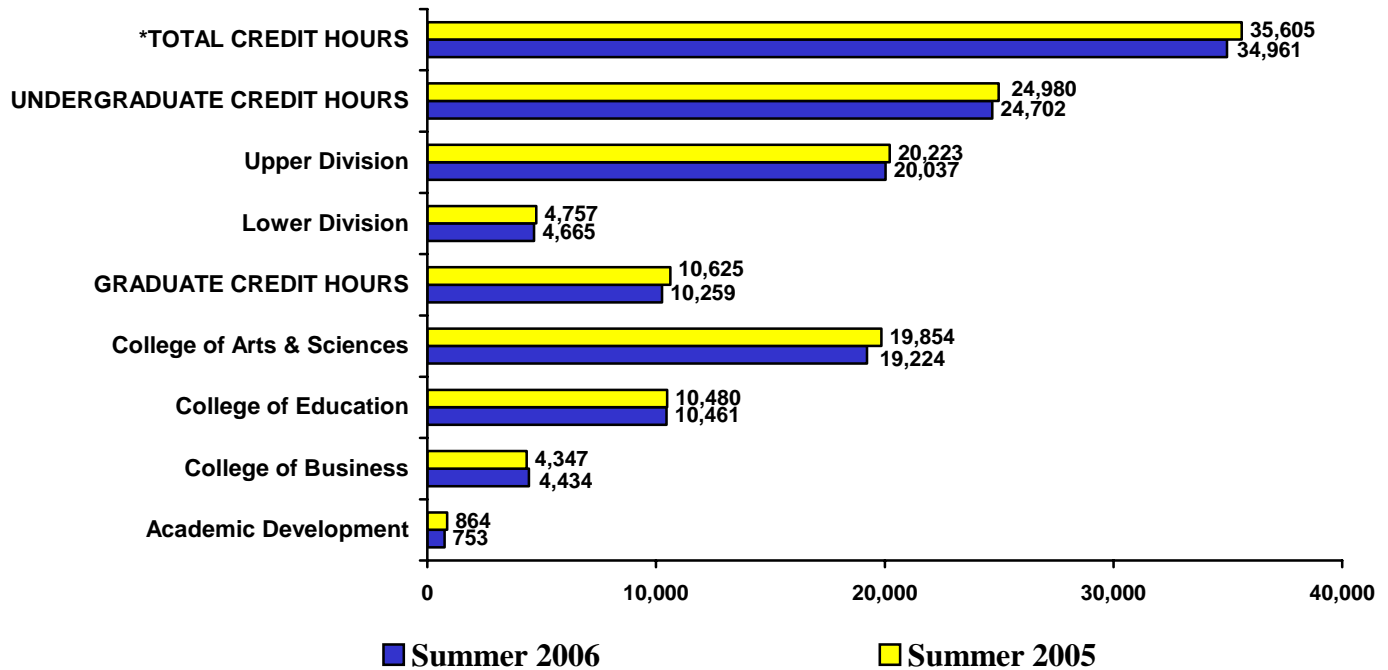

## Comparison of Student Enrollment and FTE



- A comparison with last summer (2005) shows a slight decline in both overall enrollments (2.7%) and Student FTE (1.9%). These decreases were due primarily to lower enrollments (6.9%) at the graduate level.

## Comparison of Student Credit Hours by Level and by College



\*Total Credit Hours includes Honors, NSEP, and non-traditional credit hours.

- Credit hour productivity remained relatively flat from the previous summer (1.8% decrease). The only college to experience an increase was the College of Business and Management with an additional eighty-seven student credit hours generated.
