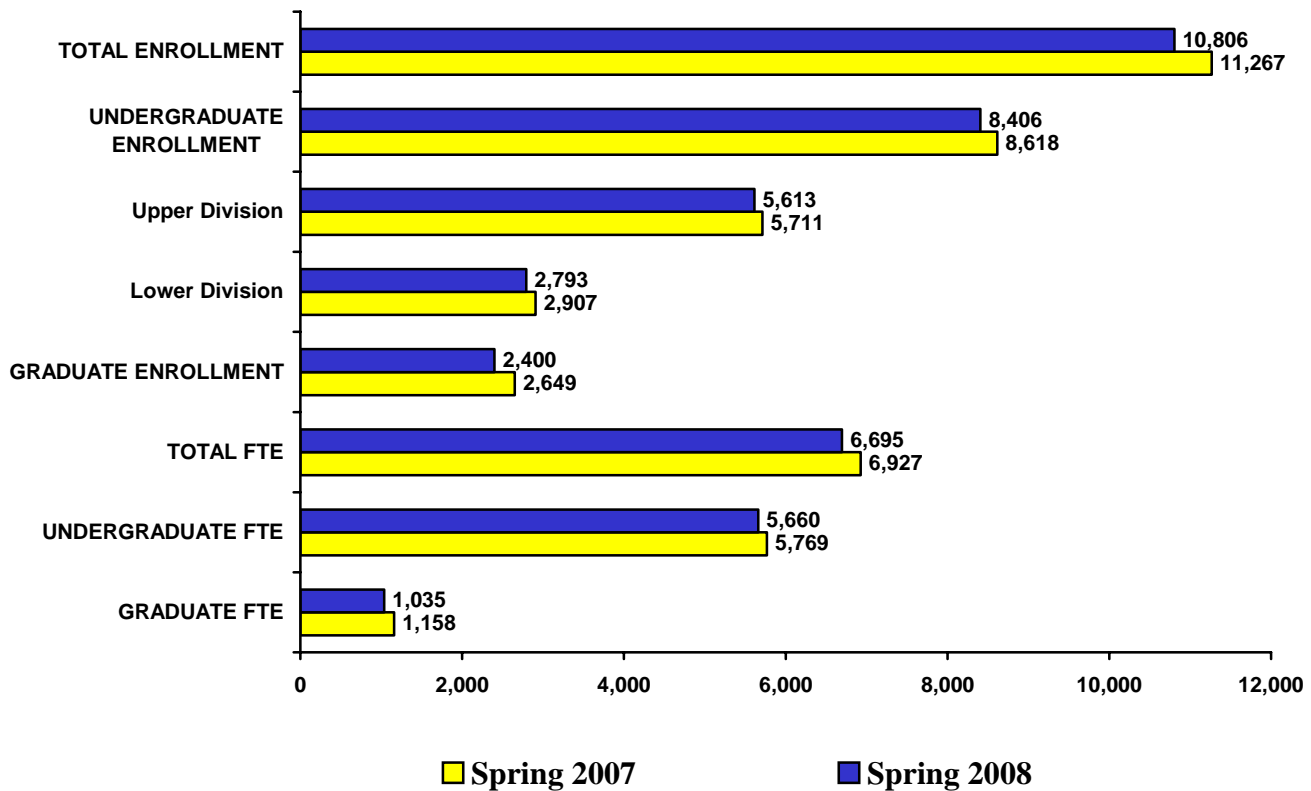

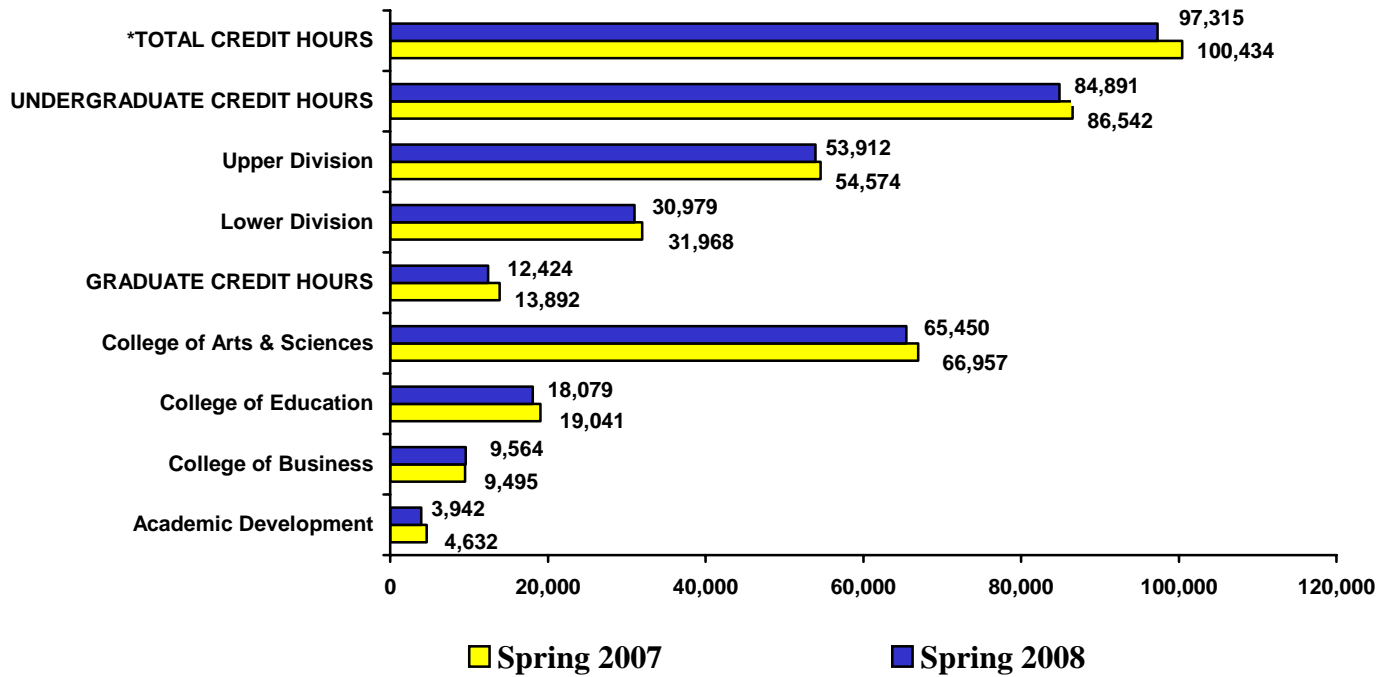
Comparison of Student Enrollment and FTE



Overall enrollment for spring, 2008 is 10,806, representing a modest 4.1% decrease over spring, 2007 enrollments; both undergraduate and graduate enrollments declined, 2.5% and 9.4%, respectively.

There was a slight decrease (1.9%) in undergraduate student FTE, and a more significant decrease of 10.6% at the graduate level, resulting in an overall decline of 3.3%.

Comparison of Student Credit Hours by Level and by College



*Total Credit Hours includes Honors, NSEP, and non-traditional credit hours.

The number of student credit hours generated by spring 2008 enrollments declined 3.1% from the previous spring. Decreases were experienced at all student levels and in all colleges with the exception of the College of Business & Management which produced slightly more student credit hours (0.7%).
