STATE OF ILLINOIS TESTING REQUIREMENTS FOR COLLEGE OF EDUCATION CANDIDATES

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) works with the Illinois Certification Testing Service (ICTS) to administer the tests below. Most tests are offered six times per year. You must advance register 6-7 weeks prior to the test date. When you complete test materials, indicate that your scores should be sent to NEIU. Once you have taken the test, your score will be available in 4-5 weeks. (Be sure you make multiple copies of your score reports as you will need documentation that indicates you have passed these tests for various applications and course authorizations.)

ICTS Basic Skills Test

Proof of successful passage of this test must be submitted to the College of Education before a student can be admitted to the College. [Note: Inner City Studies and Human Resource Development Majors are not required to take the Basic Skills Test.]

ICTS Subject Area Test

Teacher Education candidates must pass their ICTS subject area test prior to approval for student teaching/ practicum/ internship. Contact the Clinical Experiences and Student Teaching Office (CLS 4023) for specific pre-student teaching deadlines. [Note: Inner City Studies Majors and HRD majors are not required to take this test.]

ICTS Assessment of Professional Teaching Test (APT)

Teacher Education candidates for teacher certification must pass the APT test prior to receiving state certification. It is recommended that this test be taken during the student teaching semester. [Note: Inner City Studies Majors and HRD majors are not required to take this test.]

Completed forms and required documentation must be submitted to the College of Education (CLS 4044.)

NOTE: In order for your application to be processed, all completed forms and required documentation needs to be submitted at the same time.
