PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Teacher Certification Program (TCP) contains both professional and general education requirements established by the Illinois State Board of Education.

Most applicants already will have completed many required general education courses during their undergraduate studies.

During the application process, all transcripts will be reviewed, to assess which requirements have been met.

Completion of the TCP Program can result in certification in one of the following areas:

TYPE 04	Early Childhood Education	Birth – Grade 3
TYPE 03	Elementary Education	Grades K-9
TYPE 09	Secondary Education (BIO, ENGL,HIST,MATH)	Grades 6-12
TYPE 10	Secondary Education (ART, MUSIC, PE, SPAN, FR)	Grades K-12
