Northeastern Illinois University Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ A 3.00 minimum cumulative GPA and an A.A. or A.S. degree is required.
- ✓ Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- ✓ Non-Illinois residents, part-time students, individuals with Associate of Applied Science, and Bachelor's Degrees are not eligible.
- ✓ Include an official college transcript with application.
- ✓ Verification and recommendation from a Phi Theta Kappa advisor is required.
- ✓ The student **must enroll immediately for the Fall 2011 semester as a full-time student following two-year college graduation** since the scholarship covers tuition for the **first 60 credit hours** of enrollment at NEIU. The award *does not cover fees or books.*
- ✓ Award amount: One renewable full-tuition (in-state tuition) scholarship.
- ✓ In order to renew the scholarship, a 3.00 cumulative GPA must be achieved.
- ✓ Submission deadline for the 2011-2012 academic year: **March 15, 2011**

Please include with your application the following materials:

- ✓ Résumé: Highlighting your leadership positions, academic honors, special awards, work experience, and community service. **Include information regarding active involvement in your Phi Theta Kappa Chapter.** (Must be typed)
- ✓ Essay: How would you define educational success while attending Northeastern Illinois University? (Typed, one page minimum)
