**COMPREHENSIVE EXAMINATION**

Students undertaking the Research Paper option must take a written or oral comprehensive exam before a Committee consisting of three faculty members from whom they took graduate courses applicable toward the M.A. Chairperson must be a full time faculty member; normally, the Program Advisor is chair.
