University Honors Program Merit Tuition Scholarship Application

This competitive award is offered annually in recognition of overall academic achievement and excellence. To be eligible to apply for scholarship consideration, you must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and be in good academic standing in the UHP. Any grade of 'I' must be completed prior to acceptance to avoid forfeiture of award; UHP academic criteria must be maintained throughout the term of the award to avoid forfeiture. Students must enroll in at least one Honors or Honors adapted course during each semester of the award, and they must carry a minimum of six credit hours each term.

The annual deadline for award consideration is July 15. (The summer deadline is April 15.)

- Completed or in-progress Adapted Course Form, if applicable. If an Adapted course will be part of your summer or fall course load, you must submit an in-progress Adapted Course form to be considered for a scholarship.
