- Summer 2012 sessions will be on Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday from June 25<sup>th</sup> thru July 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Each day there is a morning and an afternoon section.
- In the morning session, there is a 9am time slot and a 10:30 time slot.
- In the afternoon session, there is a 12:30pm time slot and a 1:45pm time slot.
- Younger children will be assigned to the 9am or the 12:30pm time slot.
- Older children will be assigned to the 10:30am time slot or to the 1:45 pm time slot.
- The Reading Center Coordinator makes final decisions on the placement of children in the appropriate time slot.

\_\_\_\_\_ I am interested in individual tutoring for my child in the Community Program. The Community Program is designed to meet the needs of children unable attend the graduate program because of scheduling problems or lack of space. The tutoring program is \$40.00 an hour. Tutors are outstanding graduates of the Graduate Student Program. All children in the Community Program receive a brief initial evaluation prior to instruction. A brief written report of the evaluation and instruction is available for an additional charge as determined by the Reading Center Coordinator and agreed upon by the tutor and parents. The charge for a comprehensive evaluation and written report of the evaluation is \$200.00.
