



University Honors Program Admission Application

The University Honors Program is designed to give highly motivated, academically inquisitive students a distinct advantage when entering the professional world or graduate school. Enrich your college experience by joining others who share a commitment to excellence and integrity in scholarship, research, and creative expression. Benefits include priority registration, small class sizes, and personal academic advisement. Successful applicants who submit application materials by July 15 will be considered for an annual Honors Program Merit Tuition Scholarship.

Application Eligibility and Instructions

To be eligible for admission and scholarship consideration, entering freshmen applicants must rank in the top 10 percent of their high school graduating class, or have a minimum ACT score of 25 or an SAT score of 1200. Transfer applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5. Students who do not meet these criteria can apply to the Honors Program by submitting a portfolio of exceptional work. Consideration for admission and scholarship requires a completed application form, an application essay, and a statement of academic purpose. You must have a minimum of 3 semesters of study remaining at NEIU (including summer) to apply.

To be considered for a UHP merit award, you must be admitted to NEIU and the UHP and submit the application essay by July 15, the final deadline to be considered for an annual UHP Merit Tuition Scholarship.
