## Undergraduate Major and Minor Declaration Form Instructions

- 1) Declare a major or pre-major by the time you have earned 45 semester hours.
- 2) Select only one major, pre-major, or minor per form. For example, if you are declaring both a major and a minor, you will need two forms.
- 3) Indicate whether you are declaring or removing (undeclaring) a major or minor. In addition, indicate which major or minor you are declaring or removing (undeclaring).
- 4) Submit completed form to Enrollment Management Services (D-101) for processing. You may also email the completed form to [declare@neiu.edu](mailto:declare@neiu.edu).

### Pre-Majors

Students intending to major in business, education, or graphic design, can declare a "Pre-Major" until the program admission requirements to the College of Business and Technology, Daniel L. Goodwin College of Education, or the BFA in Graphic Design are met. Indicate that you are declaring a major, mark the appropriate pre-major you wish to declare and obtain the approval of the program. (See number 4 above for submission instructions)

Once the program admission requirements are met, you will need to formally declare your business, education, or graphic design major by completing and submitting a new Undergraduate Major Declaration form.

### K-12 Licensure Programs

In addition to declaring your K-12 Licensure program with the Daniel L. Goodwin College of Education, students must declare a major in their discipline with the College of Arts and Sciences.

### Declaring A Minor

Students declaring a College of Business and Technology minor must meet the admission requirements for the minor and obtain approval from the College of Business and Technology. Students declaring minors in other areas should complete the form and submit it to Enrollment Management Services. (See number 4 above for submission instructions)

### Remove (Undeclare) Your Major/Minor

If you no longer wish to major/pre-major or minor in an area that you previously declared, use this form and **A**) indicate what you are removing (e.g., major, minor, etc.) and **B**) mark the major/pre-major or minor you wish to remove (undeclare). No program advisor signature is required. (See number 4 above for submission instructions)
