If you do not meet one of the criteria listed on the FAFSA, you will be reviewed as a dependent student, meaning that your parents must provide income and asset information. In reviewing an appeal for a Change in Dependency Status, the federal guidelines suggest that the financial aid administrator consider those situations where it is necessary for the student to live separately from parents. This does not include students who make a voluntary decision to leave home nor does it include students who married after the completion of the FAFSA. If you believe that your file warrants re-evaluation as an independent student, please submit this form along with all requested documents to the NEIU Financial Aid Office. A determination will be made and you will be notified in writing. 1. On a separate sheet of paper, please attach a typewritten explanation addressing the necessary separation from your parents, qualifying you to be considered an independent student. Please attach any supporting documentation of your circumstance(s). INCOMPLETE REQUESTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. 2.
