### **Job Opening**

The Well Resource Center is a Chicago-based NFP that provides mental, physical, and relational support services for First Responders and their families. Specifically, The Well provides community groups, social groups, support groups, and professional counseling services for Chicago First Responders and their families.

The Well is hiring for a Counselor/Therapist position (Licensed Professional Counselor – LPC).

The Counselor/Therapist position at The Well Resource Center includes providing quality clinical therapeutic services to patient populations and their families/significant others. In addition to providing quality clinical therapeutic services, duties also include serving as a member of the counseling center team, supporting the organization's treatment program and philosophy, and assuring the deliverance of quality treatment.

#### Responsibilities:

- *Maintain a full-time caseload of clients.*
- *Maintain a full-time caseload conducting intake sessions, treatment planning, and entering progress notes into HER in timely fashion.*
- *Caseload expected is 20-25 sessions per week*
- *Work closely with The Well leadership to develop and implement improvement initiatives and changes as needed to enhance the quality of care and services.*
- *Attend team meeting once a month.*
- *Support therapy providers in facilitating and documenting proper assessments, recommendations, and referrals.*
- *Participate in growth initiatives to provide a variety of specialized care for all clients.*
- *Consistently adhere to HIPAA, IMHCA/ ICA, NBCC, and ACA guidelines for proper implementation of ethical, legal, and cultural standards of care*

#### Experience:

- *Master's Degree or above in areas of Clinical Psychology, Counseling Psychology, or Social Work.*
- *Hold the following licenses: LPC, LCPC or LCSW*
- *Minimum of two years' experience in the mental health field.*
- *Experience working with a counseling/mental health team.*
- *Expertise + training in working with trauma in families, parents, children, and adults.*

- EMDR is a plus

Requirements:

*Trauma informed therapist with couples counseling experience.*

*Open and flexible to working with kids, teens, and adults with varying presentations*

***Available to work 2-3 evening shifts weekly***
