- The program has a unique focus that goes beyond traditional MA programs in developmental psychology.

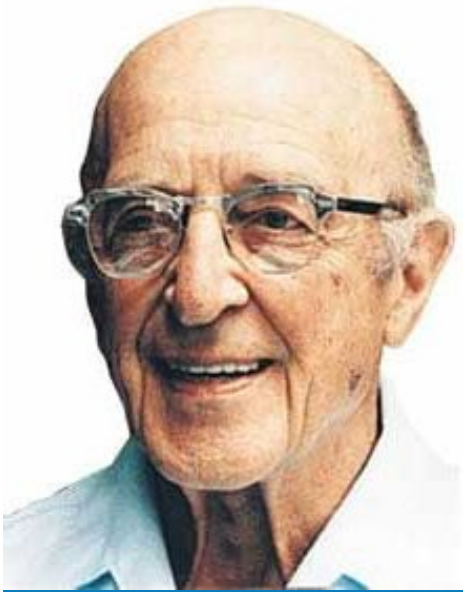
4. Why would you recommend this program to Psychology students?

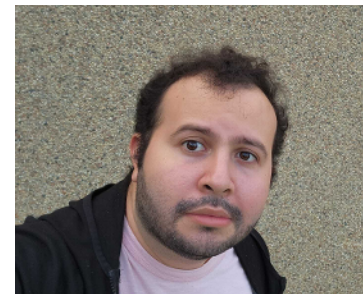
