



Academic Standards Committee Instructions for Petitioning

Any undergraduate, second bachelor's degree, undergraduate student-at-large or graduate student-at-large who has been "Academically Dismissed" from Northeastern Illinois University may appeal to the **Academic Standards Committee** for reinstatement after one term.

Graduate students in a master's degree, certificate, endorsement or licensure program must contact the College of Graduate Studies and Research at 773-442-6012 / graduatestudies@neiu.edu.

This petition process requires: **1)** a petition letter, and **2)** a completed admission application.

Petition **deadlines** are as follows:

July 15	for the Fall term
November 15	for the Spring term
March 15	for the Summer term

Your **petition letter** should include the following information and it should be typewritten, logically organized and edited for errors:

- Name
- NEIU Student ID
- Current Address and Telephone Number(s)
- State the circumstances that contributed to your being academically dismissed.
- State what you have been doing since you left Northeastern. List any activities, community college course work, completion of incompletes, etc., which indicate that you have been making a serious effort to improve your record.
- State why you are ready to be readmitted to Northeastern. Include plans such as a change in working hours, a job change, etc., which may allow you to be more successful in your future studies.

Please note:

- Up to sixty four (64) hours of college credit may be transferred from a regionally accredited two-year institution. Once a student has completed 64 hours of college credit at a two-year institution no further credit hours from a two-year institution will apply to the minimum 120 hours needed for graduation.
