Master of Arts in Community and Teacher Leaders

Teacher Leader Concentration (10 courses): This option provides knowledge and skills related to leadership, peer mentoring and professional development; promotes positive school culture that focuses on achievement; highlights equity as a means of empowerment, uses data to improve educational outcomes; and promotes building collaborative relationships with communities. Focusing on social justice and the strengths of diversity, this concentration leads to a Master's Degree and the ISBE recognized Teacher Leader Endorsement. A current Illinois Professional Educator License in teaching is required.

Community Leader Concentration (10 courses): This option provides knowledge and skills that foster leadership in ethical and culturally sensitive public engagement; acknowledges and considers the complexities of local and global communities; promotes collaborating with schools to empower communities; and leverages community assets to promote social justice and equity.
