Pre-Majors

Students intending to major in business, education, or graphic design, can declare a "Pre-Major" until the program admission requirements to the College of Business and Management, Daniel L. Goodwin College of Education, or the BFA in Graphic Design are met. Indicate that you are declaring a major, mark the appropriate pre-major you wish to declare, obtain the approval of the program, and submit the completed form to Enrollment Management Services.

Once the program admission requirements are met, you will need to formally declare your business, education, or graphic design major by completing and submitting another Undergraduate Major/Minor Declaration form.

K-12 Licensure Programs

In addition to declaring your K-12 Licensure program with the Daniel L. Goodwin College of Education, students must declare a major in their discipline with the College of Arts and Sciences.

Declaring A Minor

Students declaring a College of Business and Management minor must meet the admission requirements for the minor and obtain approval from the College of Business and Management. Students declaring minors in other areas should complete the form and submit it to Enrollment Management Services.
