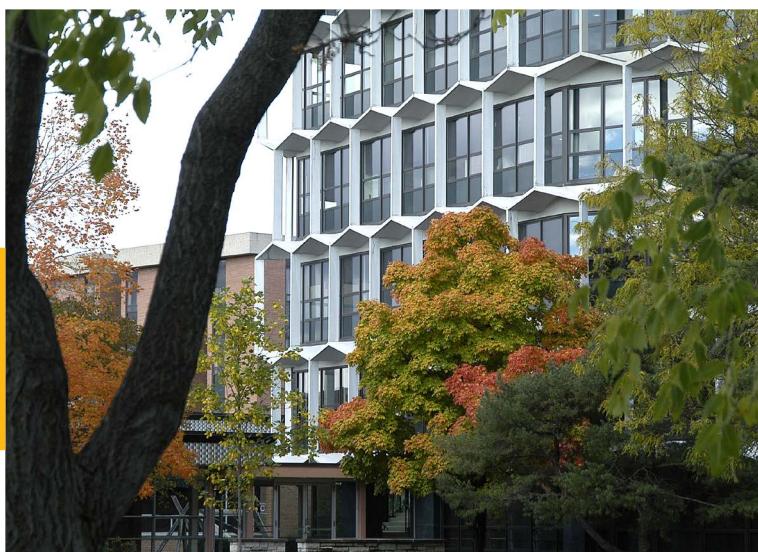

# ABOUT THE NEIU FOUNDATION

The Northeastern Illinois University Foundation is committed to providing support for the students and faculty of Northeastern through private, philanthropic donations.

Since 1969, the NEIU Foundation has existed as an independent, 501(c)3, nonprofit corporation in the State of Illinois and as the official fundraising and private gift-receiving agency for Northeastern Illinois University.

Over the years, the Foundation has worked to provide a range of support, especially scholarship support, to students who demonstrate need and/or achievement. In this brochure, you will see listed the more than 100 scholarships funded through private gifts to the NEIU Foundation.

- Endowed scholarships award annual interest income yielded from the investment of the donor's original gift. The NEIU Foundation manages the investment of the original gift, which remains intact and is grown over time. Because only the interest income is awarded, endowed scholarships are perpetual funds.
- Many of the NEIU Foundation's scholarships are named in honor or memory of a donor's loved one.
- Awardable amounts from an endowed scholarship may vary from year to year. Endowed scholarship amounts are calculated on a three-year rolling average to remain as consistent as possible.
- Annually-funded scholarships rely on a donor's gift to the scholarship fund each year, which is then awarded in the course of one year. In some cases, these are larger sums that are spent down over the course of several years.
- Students may be eligible for more than one Foundation scholarship.
- Because these scholarships are funded through private donations, students from countries other than the U.S., or students who live in the U.S. but are not U.S. citizens, are not prohibited from receiving most Foundation scholarships, so long as they meet scholarship criteria.

In addition to the scholarships available through the Foundation, there are a variety of state, federal and locally-funded financial aid opportunities available through the Office of Scholarships at Northeastern Illinois University.

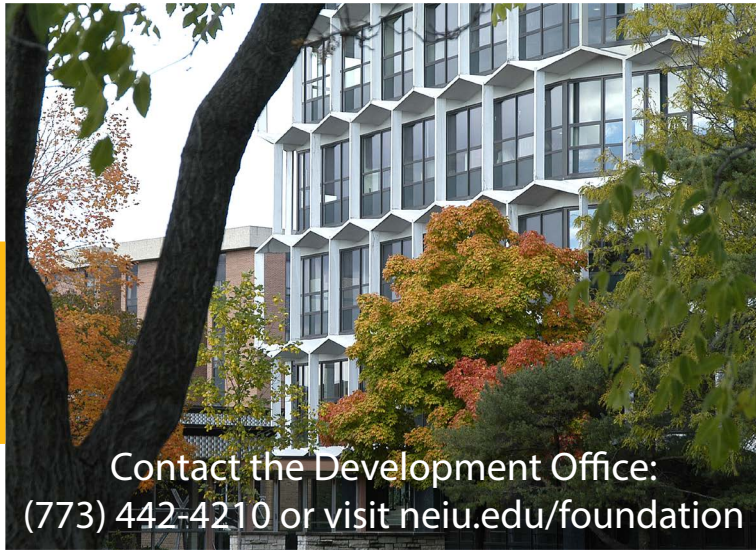
