

NEIU ALUMNI ASSOCIATION STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

The NEIU Alumni Association is now extending membership to current Northeastern students who have achieved second semester freshman, sophomore, junior or senior status, as well as all second semester transfer and graduate students. Student members receive the same Blue & Gold level benefits, in addition to various other professional development experiences on campus and with our alumni community of over 83,000 members. They may also serve as NEIUAA student representatives at events.

Student Membership Requirements

- **1. Status:** Must be current Northeastern students who have achieved second semester freshman, sophomore, junior or senior status, or second semester transfer or graduate students.
- 2. Student Engagement: NEIUAA Student Membership is free, but requires student engagement in a minimum of three (3) activities per semester. Engagement opportunities may include, but are not limited to, holding student leadership positions, volunteering with the Office of Alumni Relations, participating in service projects, managing the Class Gift Campaign and MUCH more.
- 3. Student Philanthropy: NEIUAA Student Members will support Student Philanthropy Initiative efforts in providing a welcoming environment for NEIU students by educating students on the importance of giving during their academic career, raising funds for scholarships, completing service projects, creating philanthropic traditions, hosting student life activities that build school spirit throughout the university, and encouraging peers to donate their time, talent, and treasure to NEIU.
- 4. Alumni Association Student Member Application: Pick up or download an application from the Office of Alumni Relations (www.neiu.edu/Alumni). Complete application and submit to the Office of Alumni Relations. Once the minimum of three activities per semester is met, the student is considered a Student Member of the NEIU Alumni Association and granted all privileges at the upgraded Blue and Gold membership level.

Student members of the NEIU Alumni Association will be included in volunteer opportunity communications where they can sign up to participate in events as a volunteer.

All student members are encouraged to apply for scholarships offered by the Office of Alumni Relations and the NEIU Alumni Association.
