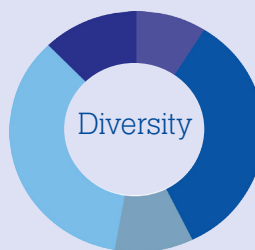

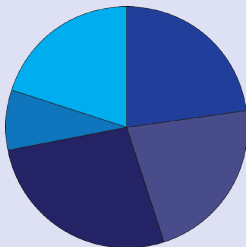

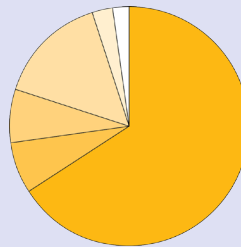

Transforming Lives, the University’s first inaugural fundraising campaign, ended in Dec. 2018, and raised a total of **\$12.87 million** in gifts, pledges and planned gifts, **exceeding the \$10 million goal.**
