1. Candidates in the Early Childhood Program will complete clinical hours in bilingual settings: ECED 327A (100 hrs.) & ECED 327B (100hrs.).
2. TESL 301 is suggested to be able to add the ESL endorsement. Since your BLBC 439 or BLBC 329 is in a bilingual **AND ESL setting**, you **DO NOT** need to take TESL 399.

In addition, students must complete an ESL clinical totaling 100 contact hours (TESL 399) in order to be entitled for the endorsement by NEIU.</p> <p>Students who do not complete TESL 399 at NEIU must apply for their endorsement through their Regional Officer of Education. Documentation including demographics of school -- all on official letterhead and signed by district administrator OR 3 months teaching experience with ESL students including demographics of school -- all on official letterhead and signed by district administrator, must be provided to the ROE.</p>

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
