Required Documents for certain Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeals:

Appeal due to medical reasons:

- Doctor's note on letterhead stating nature of illness, current health condition, release to resume coursework and the affect on your studies (past and future).
- Copies from hospital or clinic bill detailing dates involved and medical condition.

Appeal due to personal reasons:

- Professional statement of support from person(s) involved in or aware of the situation (e.g., counselor, advisor, priest, social worker, or therapist).
- Birth or death certificate or obituary (if appropriate). State nature of relationship accordingly.

Appeal due to academic reasons:

- Professional statement from departmental academic advisor supporting your academic progress, detailing an academic plan of action and/or providing reasoning behind exceeding the maximum hour time frame.
- Degree audit or graduation checklist from an academic advisor outlining graduation date, remaining courses, and credit hours required to complete program.
