***Teaching Modality Definitions**

OL: Online (Asynchronous) Learning: Asynchronous online courses are not scheduled at a specific time and day. They are project based with deadlines and will use D2L as the main platform. The faculty member teaching the course will hold office hours using a digital platform. Faculty may schedule bonus sessions that are interactive via the internet.

RL: Remote (Synchronous) Learning: Remote learning courses meet using a virtual classroom tool *at the time and date scheduled* in the course schedule. Remote learning courses may also use asynchronous learning methods. The virtual classroom tool will probably be Zoom. The faculty member teaching the course will hold office hours using a digital platform or maybe on campus in a classroom.

HY: Hybrid: Some of the graduate courses are going to be changed to hybrid. That means there will be some combination of in-person on campus and online teaching at the scheduled time.
