Students must progress in their UHP advising plan during the term of the award and carry a minimum of six credit hours each semester. To avoid forfeiture, any grade of 'I' must be resolved prior to start of award and UHP academic criteria must be maintained throughout the term of the award.

The annual deadline for award consideration is July 15. (The summer deadline is April 1.)
