

Measure: Six-Year Graduation Rate (Goal 1)

General Definition:

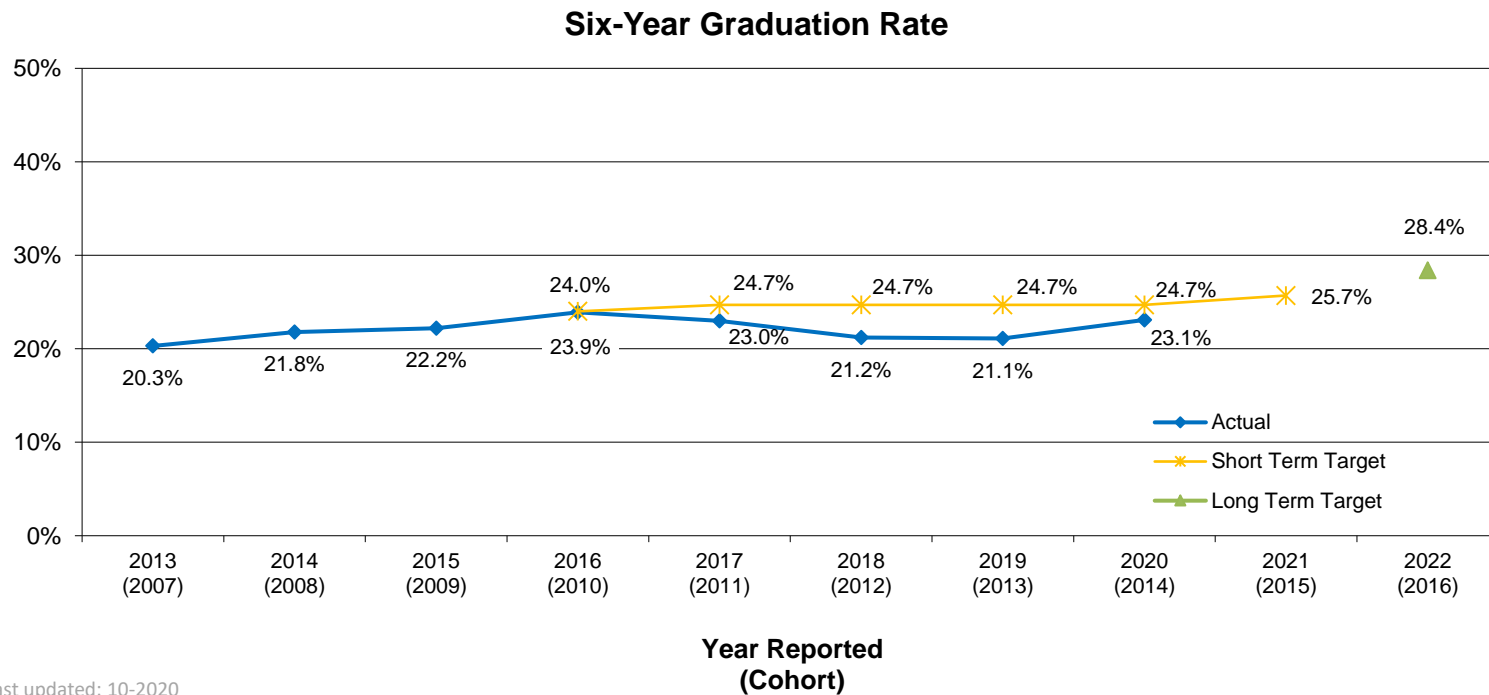
Percent of first-time, full-time freshmen who graduate within six years

Frame of Reference:

Frame of reference is set by Northeastern's urban peers, whose graduation rates range from 14% to 50%. The long term target for the life of Northeastern's Strategic Plan is 28.4%. The short term target (currently 25.7%) is reviewed annually and revised if necessary.

Frequency of Measurement:

This KPI is measured each Fall term.
