Dramatic Play

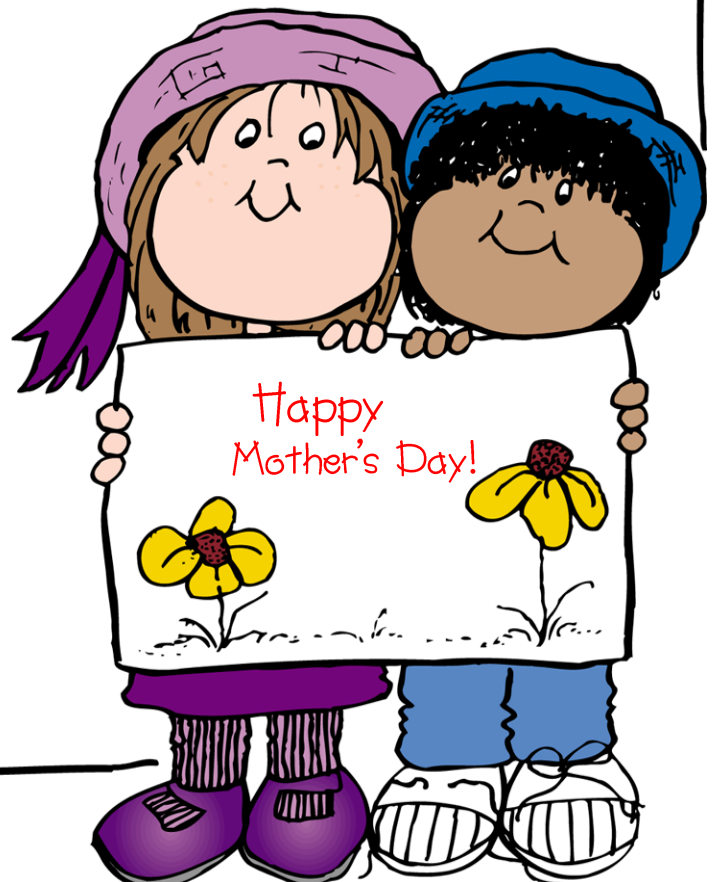
