Our theme for May will be "Spring with the Animals". We will learn about the many changes that take place in the Spring: the changes in the weather as well as in the animals around us. We will see how a caterpillar turns into a butterfly and watch as the birds return from their winter homes. Our kids are enjoying watching the robins outside as they build a nest in a nearby tree and eat from some bird feeders. They will also help Miss Debbie feed the squirrels some bread.

As we read *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, we learn how a tiny caterpillar becomes a beautiful butterfly. As an art project we will use egg cartons to make caterpillars and then transform them into butterflies with multicolored wings. We will also be making bird feeders out of pine cones.

We are continuing our movement activities to help the children develop their coordination and attention span. They will be marching with the animals and learning how each animal walks and begin to recognize what sounds each animal makes.

Our color for the month is PURPLE. Purple Day will be on Thursday May 16th. Bring (or wear) something PURPLE to school on that day.
