

## THE BROMMEL- MILLER TEACHING AS TRANSFORMATION SCHOLARSHIP

**Award amount for 2019-2020 = \$700.00**

The scholarship shall be made available to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- a. Undergraduate student accepted into the Goodwin College of Education at Northeastern Illinois University;
- b. Declared major that leads to teaching licensure and evidence of steady academic progress toward degree completion. Preference shall be given to applicants who have declared a double major (secondary education) or minor (elementary education) in humanities (e.g. English, Social Studies, Art, Theatre, Communications, Music);
- c. Minimum Grade Point Average of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale;
- d. Written essay describing the ways that the applicant has contributed to/ volunteered in his or her community or a community in need. In the written essay, at least one paragraph should speak to the reasons why the applicant wants to teach;
- e. Two letters of recommendation from people (such as: university faculty, doctor, high school teacher, clergy, long time family friends or others) who have first- hand knowledge of the applicants' contribution to/ volunteer work in his or her community or a community in need.

Applications should be submitted to the Dean's Office of the Daniel L. Goodwin College of Education (LWH 4044) **no later than March 1, 2020.**
