Differences between Subsidized and Unsubsidized Direct Loans ...

Subsidized Loans: Are based on financial need, as determined by the federal need analysis process; interest is paid by the federal government while the borrower is in school at least half-time, throughout the six month grace period and during periods of deferment. The Financial Aid Office will automatically review your subsidized eligibility.

Unsubsidized Loans: Are not based on the student's financial need; and the borrower is responsible for the interest from the date the funds are disbursed. The Financial Aid Office will not review this eligibility unless you check this box.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a U.S. Citizen or national or eligible non-citizen
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as established by the University
- Be enrolled on at least a half-time (six credit hours) basis in an eligible degree or eligible licensure program
- Student at Large statuses are not eligible for Title IV assistance
- Comply with Selective Service registration requirements
- Not be in default on any student loan or owe a refund on a grant
