


- Enrollment is down for most sectors, with the exception of new graduate degree seeking students, which increased from last year by 9.8% causing the graduate FTE to also increase by .8 percent.
- Total enrollment for the University is down 5.0% (546 students), with total graduate enrollment showing a decline of 0.4% (8 students). Total FTE is down 5.2% (360 FTE).
- New freshmen entering Northeastern have declined 4.6 % (37students) compared to Fall 2013. This contributes to a 9.7% decline in lower division students.



\*NOTE: Percent change is not reported for College of Arts and Sciences and Developmental Courses because of a definitional change. All the Developmental courses are removed from Arts and Sciences total and moved to the Developmental category. These include: ELP 112, 114, 120; READ 115, 116; and MATH 090, 091, 092.
