## Enrollment Fact Sheet <br> Spring, 2014 <br> Office of Institutional Research



- Total headcount enrollment for spring 2014 is 9,703 students, representing a 5.6 percent decrease from spring 2013. The total FTE spring enrollment decreased by 7.4 percent compared to last year. Undergraduate total enrollment 7,957 is down 5.7 percent and their FTE also decreased by 7.8 percent from the previous spring term.
- The new freshmen enrollment decreased from 64 to 50 students by 21.9 percent, and new transfer enrollment decreased by 12.4 from previous year. Lower division enrollment decreased 10.8 and upper division decreased 3.4. Graduate total enrollment is 1,746 students and is down 5.0 percent from the previous spring term. Graduate FTE enrollment shows a decrease of 5.1 percent since spring 2013.

- The total number of student credit hours generated in spring of 2014 is 90,187 a decrease of 7.5 percent from the previous spring term. In the lower division undergraduate credit hours there is a decrease of 11.4 percent and the upper division is only down by 6.0 percent. Graduate-level credit hours declined 5 percent.
- College of Arts and Sciences generated 66,514 student credit hours, accounting for 73.7 percent of the university total but is down 6.5 percent from the previous spring. Student credit hours in the College of Education declined 12.8 per cent while the College of Business decreased by 3.3 percent and Developmental courses decreased 24.4 percent.
