

Enrollment Fact Sheet Fall, 2012

Office of Institutional Research



- Enrollment is down for nearly all sectors, with the exception of new freshmen (up 9.5%, or 90 students) and new graduate students (up 8.4%, or 27 students).
- Total enrollment for the University is down -3.7% (431), with graduate enrollment showing the largest relative decline (-6.9%, or 150 students). Total FTE is down -3.6% (274).
- It appears that new students are entering the University at a higher rate than last fall but continuing students are returning at a lower rate.



- Total student credit hours (SCH) are down -3.5% (or 3,930) from last fall.
- Most of the decline in SCH is from College of Education, -11.6 (or 2,044), College of Art s and Sciences, -2.6% (or 2,050) and graduate level (-6.9%, or 831).
- College of Business show a slight increase (0.6%, or 55) and the Developmental Courses more substantial (2.6%, or 108).
