
Enrollment Fact Sheet Spring, 2013




Total headcount enrollment in Spring 2013 is 10,276 students, representing a 4.9 percent decrease from the previous spring term. Total FTE enrollment decreased by 4.5 percent.

Undergraduate enrollment totals 8,438 students, down 3.6 percent; undergraduate FTE enrollment also decreased 3.3 percent from the previous spring term. Enrollment in the upper division showed greater decrease than lower (-4.5 vs. - 1.7 percent).

New freshmen enrollment increased from 52 to 64 students (23.1 percent), and new transfer enrollment held steady.

Graduate enrollment totals 1,838 students, down 10.1 percent from the previous spring. Graduate FTE enrollment shows a decrease of 11.7 percent.



- The total number of student credit hours generated in Spring 2013 is 97,517, decreased by 4.3 percent from the previous spring term. The decrease is in both lower division undergraduate credit hours (down 2.5 percent) and upper division (down 3.8 percent); graduate-level credit hours declined 11.7 percent.
- College of Arts and Sciences generated 71,161 student credit hours, accounting for 72.9 percent of the university total but down 3.4 percent from the previous spring. Student credit hours in the College of Education declined 12.7 per cent while the College of Business increased 1.1 percent, and Developmental courses increased 3.7 percent.
