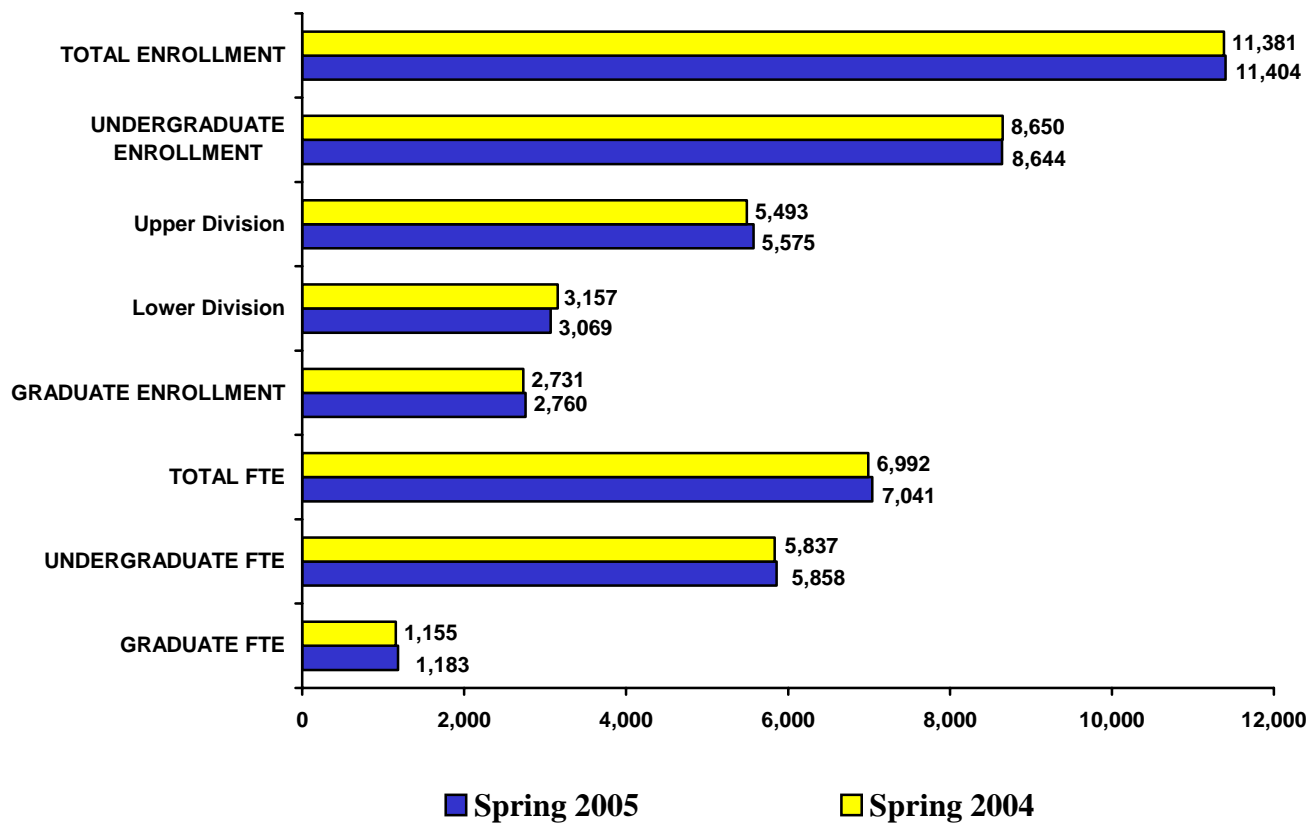

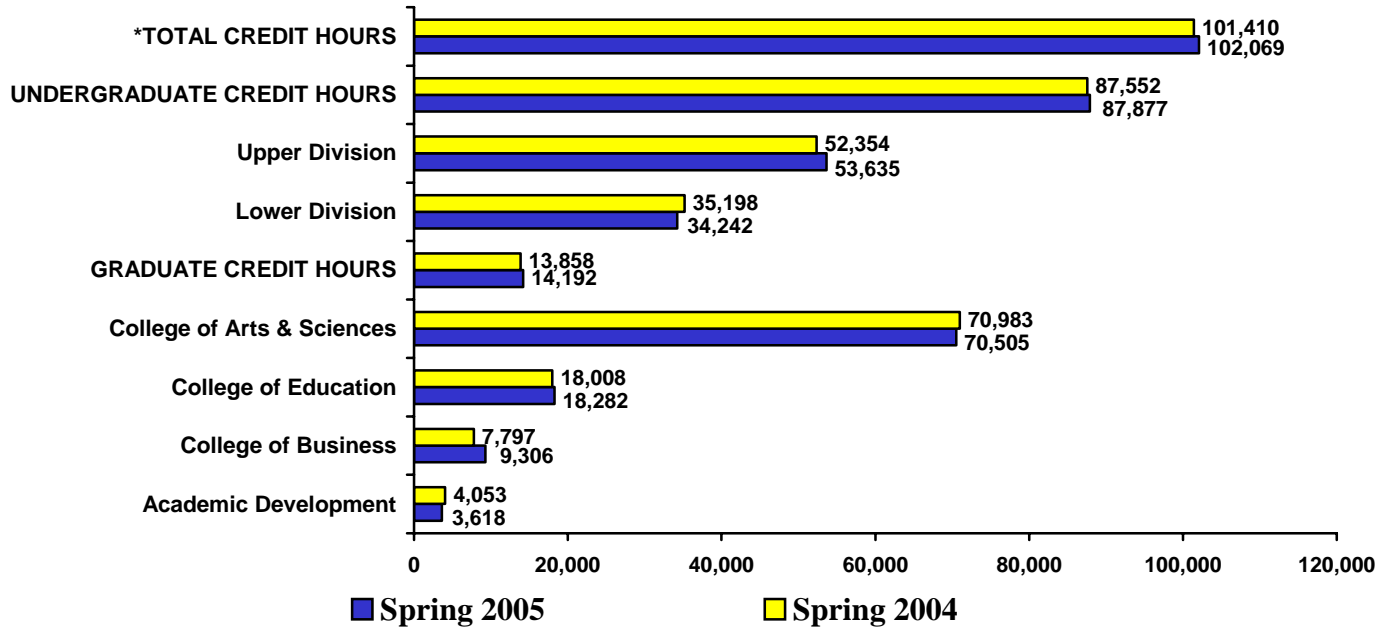

Comparison of Student Enrollment and FTE



- Total enrollment for Spring, 2005 is 11,404 students, representing a 0.2% *increase* over Spring, 2004 enrollments.
- Enrollments produced a 0.7% *increase* in Student FTE for the semester.

Comparison of Student Credit Hours by Level and by College



*Total Credit Hours includes Honors, NSEP, and non-traditional credit hours.

- Student enrollments university-wide generated a 0.6% *increase* in student credit hours for Spring, 2005.
- Within the College of Business and Management, enrollments produced a 19.4% *increase* in student credit hours for the semester.
